Yellow Mold Instructions for Fingerprint Jewelry Please read through entire instructions BEFORE beginning. Please follow these instructions closely for molding fingerprints.

*Please note this mold compound is safe and non-toxic, but not edible. Please use care when molding prints with children's little hands. This process should be completed by an adult. Complete instructions one fingerprint at a time. Each mold is individually packaged. Each individual mold contains two parts: yellow and white, 1:1 ratio. **You can view a video example of molding fingerprints at** <u>www.janewear.com/fingerprints</u>

This mold sets up at room temperature. Mold will set slower at cooler temps, and faster with warmer temps.

- 1. Wash and pat dry hands before beginning.
- 2. Prepare a molding area, a clean, dry, flat surface. (Recommend using a small dish.)
- 3. START WITH A PEA-SIZED AMOUNT FOR FIRST TRY TO SEE HOW QUICKLY IT SETS and then use additional mold as needed. Each container set holds enough for a couple trys per print ordered.
- 4. Combine a pea-sized amount of yellow and white together with fingers completely. This should be a solid color, no white streaks.
- 5. Roll mixture into a ball, then press down flat with your palm before imprinting.
- 6. Press straight down, or roll finger on mold to make fingerprint impression.
- 7. Mold will start to set within 30 seconds.
- 8. Place mold in safe area where it will not be touched while it sets up.
- 9. Let mold set for at least an hour without being touched to achieve best results and quality detail of prints.

Repeat steps if you have ordered additional prints. And wash children's hands when finished.

- Please place completed molds back in plastic bags provided. Make sure they are <u>individually</u> <u>labeled with the name of person who ordered</u> and with initials, short name, or date of your choice to be imprinted on the back of the pendant.
- If you have ordered more than one print, please label and place in individual bags.
- Your completed mold will be slightly flexible, so please return in protective bubble wrapping provided. (ps... Sending back the empty mold containers also will help us recycle!)
